

Commission membership requirements per Commission rules

5.11 Membership.

The **Planning Commission** shall consist of seven members appointed by the Mayor with the approval of Council.

Pursuant to ORS 227.030, no more than two (2) voting members of the commission may engage principally in the buying, selling or developing of real estate for profit as individuals, or be members of any partnership, or officers or employees of any corporation that engages principally in the buying, selling or developing of real estate for profit. No more than two (2) members shall be engaged in the same kind of occupation, business, trade or profession.

All commission members must reside in the City.

All commission members must have resided in the City for no less than six months prior to appointment.

5.21 Membership.

The **Parks and Commons Commission** shall consist of seven (7) members, appointed by the Mayor with consent of the Council. **One member of the commission may reside outside the City limits.**

5.31 Membership

The **Public Works & Streets Commission** shall consist of seven (7) members, appointed by the Mayor with consent of the Council.

One member of the commission may reside outside the City limits.

5.41 Membership.

The **Library Commission** shall consist of five (5) members, appointed by the Mayor with consent of Council.

One member of the commission may reside outside the City limits.

NOTE: Section 2.08.020(C) of the Yachats Municipal code concerns membership on the Public Works and Streets Commission, the Parks and Commons Commission, and the Library Commission.

C. All commission members must reside in the City. One member of the parks and commons commission may reside outside the City limits. One member of the Library Commission may reside outside the City limits. (Ord. 177 § 2, 1995)(Ord. 249, Amended, 01/20/2005)

Contrary to the Commission rules, it does not allow for any member of the Public Works and Streets Commission to reside outside the city. Either the Municipal Code or the Commission Rules needs to be amended so they are in agreement.
