

## 2021 Yachats City Goals

Rather than presenting one final draft, we have decided to give the council the same data in different formats.

**Draft #4** states the goals in bold and cites examples below for each goal. The numbers items represent examples of goals that are unclear. We are seeking clarification of the numbered items for goals listed in draft #4.

**Draft #5** also states the goals in bold and employs a more narrative format constant with previous drafts.

Both drafts goals are in the same order to facilitate comparison. The objective for water sustainability includes a comment about water storage. This is a specific outcome that has not yet been discussed or approved by this council and is inappropriate in the city goals statement at this time. We do not see a problem with the inclusion of watershed protection.

One item under the Fiscal Responsibility goal appears to be a restatement of the current CIP process. The problem may be a failure to follow the process but the plan exists and doesn't need to be reinvented. That text is below:

**Seek a plan to address and prioritize city projects.**

The plan would note projects with greatest need and consider whether they can be met in a timely manner, note projects that can be addressed with currently available funds while still looking for grant help, and note what projects will require grants or dedicated savings.
