



WATER CONSERVATION ORDINANCE PUBLIC MEETING

TUESDAY SEPTEMBER 19, 2022 – 11:00AM – 12:00PM

WHAT IS THE PURPOSE FOR THE MEETING:

The City of Yachats will be holding a public meeting via Zoom at 11 am on Monday, September 19, 2022

This meeting is a chance for community members to provide input on ideas for water conservation ordinances that the city may consider adopting.

The City developed a Drinking Water Protection Plan in 2021 that identifies potential threats to our water sources and establishes strategies to mitigate risks. One of these strategies is to promote water conservation, which would be particularly helpful in reducing summertime demand when the creeks that the city depends on for water flow at their lowest levels. Conserving water is especially important during years with low rainfall.

The city will hold two public meetings to share ideas and seek input on potential water conservation ordinances. At the September 19th meeting, we will discuss common elements of indoor and outdoor water conservation ordinances and how they might benefit our community and protect our drinking water supplies.
