### PUBLIC WORKS & STREETS COMMISSION INVOLVEMENT

1. Identify and review the various areas with Planning Representative with onsite conditions and determine the actual solutions and required implementation.
2. Identify how implementation or portions of are to be done: Outside hired contractor, PW Staff, or Commission physically doing the work.
3. Identify Costs.

There are several Commissioners that are interested in actual implementation of areas where we need to recognize the existing conditions. We need to find solutions that are less impactful to the environment, be flexible about change if the solution isn't working and be as cost efficient as possible.

Example: 4<sup>th</sup> street where we are testing the use of used fire hose to create the stripes (idea we copied from the Drift Inn).

Our (Planning & PW) need from Council is to identify what and where the priorities are and give us the latitude to determine the best solution and implement it without multiple reviews and approvals. Provide us with an approval to proceed once we identify the basic solutions and budget for the priorities you give us.
