We live at 453 and 370 Horizon Hill Rd. We want to express our opposition to the application to lock the yard debris dumpster, that is being proposed by Craig Berdie.

His application suggests, without actually knowing, that the dumpster was misused by a contractor just by the amount of debris that he saw on one occasion. His implication is that the citizens of Yachats would not have that much debris to dump in a single day.

Over the years, we have been responsible for making a large contribution to that bin in a single day, and have witnessed other residents doing so. When trees come crashing down in storms, they are not always removed by professionals, but often by local citizens

It seems like this suggestion is too severe and too expensive (\$20,000.00) for a possible misuse of the bin. We believe it would take many, many infractions to add up to the expense this application is proposing.

It will also make using the bin an unnecessary burden for the citizens and add additional work on our public works staff.
